### **Background Information**

#### **Scope and Content Note**

This collection (cataloged on Bib #688583) contains primarily correspondence by JSU employees with members of the Ryals family around the time of the University's centennial (1983), attempting to solicit information regarding the University's first president, James Gazaway Ryals, Jr. (1855-1885). The remainder of the collection is made up of photocopies of newspaper and book sections which provide details on Ryals and his family, along with handwritten notes. A portait of Ryals can be found in the JSU Photographic Collection.

Ryals was born in 1855 in Cartersville, Bartow County, Georgia. His father, Dr. James G. Ryals, Sr., was a farmer, Baptist minister, lawyer, and professor of theology at Mercer University; his mother, Mary E. Janes, was the daughter of Col. Absalom Janes, one of the founders and first trustees of Mercer University. Ryals, Jr. entered Mercer in 1875 and graduated with distinguished honors, first in his class, two years later. He was a member of the Kappa Chapter of the Kappa Alpha Fraternity at Mercer. Ryals taught for a year at a school run by his father in Cartersville before entering the University of Virginia in 1879; he graduated four years later with a Master of Arts and a post-graduate course in mixed mathematics. Ryals was appointed the first president of Jacksonville State Normal School (later Jacksonville State University) by its Board of Trustees in 1883. Ryals' tenure as president of the State Normal School lasted 18 months, until his death on 18 April 1885 from catarrhal fever (probably pneumonia), at the age of 30. He is interred in Rose Hill Cemetery in Macon, Georgia. [source: *Jacksonville News*, 11 July 1956 and various contemporary obituaries]

According to the notes and correspondence included in this collection, these materials were compiled primarily by Effie White Sawyer through her research into JSU's history, which she began conducting in 1981 in preparation for the centennial of JSU's founding. She received a great deal of information from Annie Forney Daugette, the wife of JSU President C.W. Daugette. White was assisted in her efforts by Larry Smith, an employee in JSU's Financial Aid Office, and Alta Millican, the Dean of the Library. Dr. Millican deposited these papers with the Library.
