Background Information

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains slides, printed photographs, scrapbooks and advisors' handbooks relating to the Chi Chapter of Kappa Delta Epsilon ($K\Delta E$) and the Epsilon Phi Chapter of Kappa Delta Pi ($K\Delta \pi$).

Kappa Delta Epsilon is a professional sorority for Education students that was first organized nationally in 1933. The requirements for membership are: at least sophomore standing, a major in Education, and a GPA of 3.0 or higher. The Chi Chapter was chartered at Jacksonville State Teachers College (now Jacksonville State University) on 31 March 1954. The chapter's colors are purple and white. JSU's Chi Chapter was last active in 2010.

Kappa Delta Pi is an international honor society in Education founded in 1911. The requirements for membership are a 2.5 GPA for undergraduates and a 2.75 GPA for graduate students. The chapter's colors are purple and white. The Epsilon Phi Chapter at JSU is no longer listed on the directory of chapters for the international society, and appears to be inactive.

These items were transferred to the Library by Martha Dingler, Secretary to the Dean, JSU College of Education, on 25 January 2021. They were previously located in the Ramona Wood building. See attached Memorandum.

Physical Condition

The items were originally contained in a box that appeared to be water damaged. The slides were housed in a plastic carousel inside a Kodak box that exhibited signs of mold; the slides were removed and the carousel and box discarded. The scrapbooks are in varying states of preservation (see inventory for more information on individual scrapbooks) – some have loose/missing leaves or covers, and photographs and other items appear to have been removed from scrapbook pages (the photograph points and paste show their former location) and are now lost. Most of the printed photographs were loose in the box. A newspaper clipping with names of those pictured accompanied one photograph denoting them as inductees of Kappa Delta Pi; the others have no identifying information except for the date mark on the back of the prints. Some photographs were stapled to construction paper, which has

been discarded. The Advisors' Notebooks are in good condition, with papers inside both in the pockets, loose, and within the binder rings.
