March 30, 2020

I came home and we cooked steak and lamb chops for dinner. The only bad thing about quarantine is school online. For me personally, school online is harder than in class. I was given one minute per question in a science class; however, I'm used to having an hour for about forty minutes. March 31, 2020

So, my Dad (his Pepaw) fileted the fish and cooked it for dinner. I finished up the night by taking a history test. Finally, I'm getting to relax and watch a Disney movie with my nephews in the living room where were all

sleeping. I am on the air mattress, while they're on the couches. Tomorrow, if it does not rain, Dad wants us to work on my car or the boat. I can't wait to see how that goes especially considering I have a ton of online work to do!

April 2, 2020

Today was an eventful day. I woke up and ate breakfast with my nephews. My dad woke up early because he is building a shop and the workers came and poured the concrete slab. He cooked when he got up early this morning so breakfast would be ready for us when we woke up. After I got up, my nephew wanted to ride the four-wheeler, so I took him for a ride. I also zip tied a basket onto the front and sat my dog in it so she could go. After that, I did homework for a couple of hours.

The afternoon came around and my dad told me to call the crab company to see if they were doing to go orders. He wanted to take the boat our for a ride, so we rode to the crab company and docked to get our food. Once we got there, we waited a few minutes for our food to get ready. We all ate fresh shrimp for dinner on the boat with a view. My nephews were throwing fries to the seagulls, and I just knew one of them was going to poop on me. We finally made it back to the house, and I got a shower to get ready for bed. Now I am going to study for upcoming tests until I fall asleep.

April 4, 2020

We also cleaned up the boat so we can take it out. I think we are going to take it out in a few days to the island and hang out there all day.

April 8, 2020

a very time-consuming job. My Dad had a fire going, and we cooked smores and sat by the fire. My step mom put a roast on and we ate that for supper. Overall it was a great day spent with family.

April 14, 2020

Today was a long day. I drove home from my Dad's house back to Alabama. I went back to my apartment in Jacksonville, which is like a ghost town. None of my friends are there or any of my roommates. I have to stay here because I do not have Wi-Fi at my mom's house so it is going to be lonely for a while. Luckily, I have my dog Pearl to keep me company. I spent the afternoon unpacking my clothes and cleaning up because the apartment even smelled musky from no one being here. I am tired from driving all day, so I went to bed early. I bet I sleep like a rock because I was having to sleep on an air mattress at my Dad's house because my step sister had to move into the extra bedroom.

April 16, 2020

I miss my dogs a lot when I leave and they are always so excited to see me. My mom grilled steaks on the grill for dinner and I cooked okra, corn, and baked potatoes inside. She had done a lot of work in the garden and was showing me all of her flowers.

I finished my school work up for the day before I left, so I am staying at home. I am going to snuggle with my dog Molly and Pearl will sleep with me as usual, too. I am going to watch Netflix until I fall asleep. My mom is supposed to cook biscuits and gravy in the morning. That is my favorite meal especially with a glass of sweet tea.

April 18, 2020

Today was a fun day. I drove home after finishing a test at the apartment. My mom and I called in takeout from one of our favorite restaurants. We love eating at The Ark. I grew up working there through high school and my freshman year of college. Every time I go home, I at least get some hushpuppies. My mom and I ordered the same thing we always get. We got a grilled shrimp dinner with baked potato and okra. My mom always gets an extra side of okra, too. I went and picked the food up in my Mini Cooper. I put my dog's dog bed in the back and let my seats down so they could ride. I had all the windows down and took back roads so they enjoyed the ride. It was a good day overall.

April 20, 2020

watched the first two episodes and it was so good. It was so good we all made a pact that we could only watch it when we were with each other. We also made brownies. We used my Grandmothers secret recipe and they were so good. We all ate brownies with a glass of milk and then everyone went home. I am going to go to bed here soon. Today was nice seeing a few friends.

April 22, 2020

I went and spent today at home. I did all my homework and studying before I left Jacksonville so I could visit with my family. My brother also drove home today. My brother and I went and got my little cousin to watch. He is always so much fun. We took him to the pasture to feed to horses and the donkey. He loves animals. My brother also has a snake that he loves to look at, but he is still scared of them. I went to the store and got some chicken because my brother wanted to cook tacos. Corbin was playing with Pearl and running around outside all afternoon. I gave him a bath before dinner was ready. We all ate tacos and me and Corbin watched Scooby Doo until his mom came and got him.

April 24, 2020

I spent today with one of my friends Brad. He called me and asked me if I wanted to go grocery shopping with him and help him with a finance project. We went to Walmart and got groceries and he bought stuff to make spaghetti. He wanted me to cook that night, so I told him I would. We got back from the grocery store and he got his work out. I helped him figure out the math part of his project so he was able to do well on his final and his homework. Then we both cooked spaghetti and watched tv. My dad called me right after he ate and told me I needed to come down for a few days that he needed me. So, I came home and packed and got ready to leave the next morning.

April 26, 2020

April 28, 2020

Throughout my journal, I just described what I did each day. It has been different as far as not going to school or work, but it has made me close with family as well. The only thing was that school was harder online than in class when you are not used to it. I hope my story helps people understand what it was like living during the pandemic.
