Many students who complain about our political system do not vote. There is absolutely no excuse for not voting. Even if you don't like any of the candidates on the ballot, voting is your responsibility. After all, brave Americans died face down in the mud so that you could have the right to vote.

Nineteen hundred and eighty nine was the year of democracy. We watched the dismantling of the Berlin Wall, a democratic election in Hungary, the first non-Communist government in post-war Poland, and the student movement in China.

American college students struggled for many years to gain the right to vote. Now that we have it, many students are too apathetic to take the time to vote.

What would the students in China give for the opportunity to vote? Governor Hunt says, "Students must realize how important their right to vote is and must start participating in the process."

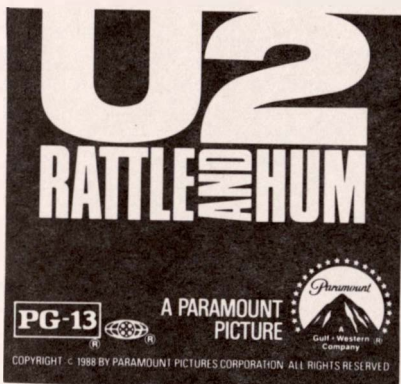

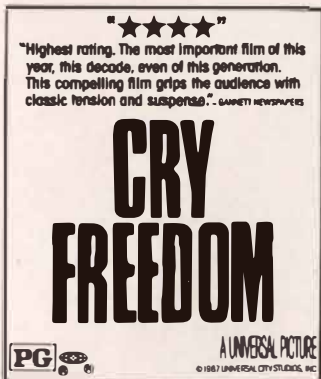

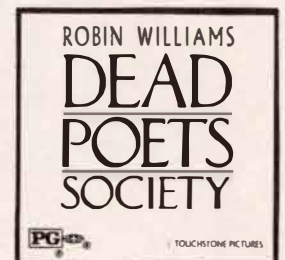
