## Background Information

### Scope and Content Note

This collection (cataloged on Bib #2314793) contains scrapbooks, photograph albums, guest books, filmstrips, and miscellaneous items found in the attic of the University's International House. Most items relate to International House and its history. Some items originally transferred with this collection (eg, LP albums of international music, 16mm films) have not been retained.

JSU's International House Program began in 1946 with four students from France and originally focused on language. While emphasis is still placed on languages, today great importance is placed on promoting global understanding and peace between all nations and cultures. Each year, 40 students are accepted to live at the House; each international student is from a different country and is roomed with an American student.
