Background Information

Scope and Content Note

This collection (cataloged on Bib #2710887) contains plaques, printed photographs, digital photographs (on CD), printed promotional materials, digital promotional materials (on CD and DVD), and assorted documents related to JSU's English Language Institute (ELI). The English Language Institute was established in 2004, the program was moved online in 2021, and ceased existence in 2022. These residual materials were then deposited with the Library.

The ELI program was designed to prepare non-native English speakers for university study in the United States. Program participants, in cohorts of 12 or less, pursued a curriculum that included: 22 hours per week of core ESL skills in Listening, Speaking, Pronunciation, Reading, and Writing; 4 hours of electives (TOEFL/IELTS Preparation, Public Speaking & Conversation, Cinema & Cultural Analysis, U.S. History, Conversation Partners); 3 hours of an "Introduction to JSU" course which included visiting university classes, meeting international students who had transitioned from language student to college student, and participation in university events and activities. There were also extra-campus activities such as trips to Atlanta and Birmingham, festivals, picnics, museums, amusement parks, etc. Participants in the ELI could also declare conditional admission to JSU and, upon successful completion of the ELI curriculum, be admitted to the university without a TOEFL or IELTS score.

DISPOSITION AGREEMENT

In order to provide appropriate preservation for and access to materials (enumerated below) relating to JSU's English Language Institute (ELI), the Library and International House & Programs enter into the following agreement.

Materials

- 1. Assorted framed items. Photographs and plaques.
- 2. English Language Institute documents. Loose-leaf and binders containing documentation on ELI participants, ELI promotional and marketing publications, and miscellaneous documents.
- 3. Printed photographs. 3 photographic albums and approximately 500 assorted prints.
- 4. Compact discs. Approximately 55 CDs containing primarily photographic image files.

International House & Programs agrees to:

1. Transfer the materials above to the permanent custody of the Library.

The Library agrees to:

- I. Accept and organize the materials.
- 2. Discard any materials not deemed appropriate for addition to the Library's collection.
- 3. Provide metadata for the materials.
- 4. Evaluate the materials for possible digitization.



5. House the materials in the Library's Alabama Gallery Special Collections, using appropriate archival storage, and providing for public access as enumerated in the Library's Alabama Gallery Policy.
