## Background Information

### Scope and Content Note

This collection (cataloged on record #2798270) contains certificates, programs from initiation ceremonies, initiation pins, and pamphlets relating to the JSU chapter of the Phi Delta Kappa (φΔΚ) Education professional association. There were also two publications – a monograph (Educational Private Practice: Your Opportunities in the Changing Marketplace) and an article in pamphlet form (Education in Private Practice) by chapter member and former JSU faculty member Dennis C. Zuelke. As the Library already held these publications in its collections, these have been added as second copies.

Phi Delta Kappa was founded in 1906, and the JSU chapter (0211) received its charter on 11 October 1973. Charter members included Mitchell W. McKay and Dr. Roland Thornburg. As of 2024, the JSU chapter was no longer active.
